

Warehouse Processing Assistants – Immediate Start

Duties and Responsibilities:

Co-ordinating, handling and packing shoeboxes into outer cartons

Despatch of cartons in containers ready for shipping

Other duties as assigned by the supervisor

Working alongside volunteers

Key Selection Criteria (please address these in your application letter):

Essential

- A degree of physical fitness is required as the role involves manual handling and lifting, with some heavy boxes up to 15kg. Lifting above shoulder height may also be involved.
- Be able to follow instructions as directed by the Supervisor
- Demonstrate values aligned with Samaritan's Purse
